Schooling Shows Rules and Regulations

1. Willowbrooke Farm will not be responsible for loss or damages to any person, property, animal, or equipment. Each exhibitor shall assume all liability and hold harmless Willowbrooke Farm for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse/pony or any of their subordinates or superiors. This shall be the condition of entry to this show and show grounds.
2. Stalls are available on a limited basis at \$60 each. One horse/pony per stall. Ship-ins are welcome with a \$25 grounds fee. Non-showing horses will be charged a \$60 non-showing fee. You must call/text Jennifer ahead to reserve stalls (313) 938-9222.
3. Entries are \$20 per class. If you are using a Willowbrooke Farm school horse, there will be an additional \$10 fee per class for horse usage. Please list your favorite 3 horses in order of preference on your entry blank. Lesson horses can go more than once in non-group classes. Show attire is encouraged but not required. A fee of \$50 will be charged on all non-negotiable checks.
4. ALL entry blanks must be accompanied by cash or check made out to Willowbrooke Farm. Entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a vet certificate. Stall fees are non-refundable 2 weeks prior to show.
5. Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes if entries warrant. Management also reserves the right to refuse any entry.
6. Schooling will be available on Friday from noon – 8:00pm. Schooling is also available Saturday morning but the ring will close 45 minutes prior to the start of the show.
7. Protective headgear is required for ALL RIDERS in all hunter, jumper, and equitation classes, and while schooling. Headgear must be properly fitted with a secured harness while riding anywhere on the show grounds and must be ASTM/SEI approved. Brim on the headgear must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until proper headgear is in place. Safety vests are allowed in all classes but not required. Willowbrooke Farm makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk. For further information, please consult the Michigan Equine Liability Act.
8. No dogs allowed. We love dogs; however, it is too busy at the show so we ask that you please leave them at home.
9. NO smoking. There is no smoking allowed in the stabling areas, indoor arena, or observation room.
10. First through sixth place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Championships will be awarded in each division with 3 or more entries. Series championships will be awarded in all divisions after the last show in the series. You must compete in 4 of the 7 shows to be eligible for a series award. There will also be a Grand Champion Hunter, Grand Champion Equitation and Grand Champion Jumper award at the end of the series. You must be jumping at 2' or higher to be eligible for these awards.
